

Certified Community Behavioral Health Center Certification Prerequisite Requirements

• Verify the CCBHC conforms to at last one of the following statutorily established criteria:

Is a non-profit organization, exempt from tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue Code; Is part of a local government behavioral health authority;

Is operated under the authority of the Indian Health Service, an Indian tribe, or tribal organization pursuant to a contract, grant, cooperative agreement, or compact with the Indian Health Service pursuant to the Indian Self-Determination Act (25 U.S.C. 450 et seq.);

Is an urban Indian organization pursuant to a grant or contract with the Indian Health Service under Title V of the Indian Health Care Improvement Act (25 U.S.C. 1601 et seq.).

- Certified as mental health clinics under section 245.69, subdivision 2:
- Licensed to provide substance use disorder treatment according to <u>state standards</u> for adults and children.
- Certified to provide children's therapeutic services and supports according to <u>state</u> standards;
- Certified to provide adult rehabilitative mental health services according to <u>state</u> <u>standards</u>;
- Enrolled to provide mental health crisis response services according to state standards for adults and children;
- Enrolled to provide adult and children's mental health targeted case management;
- Enrolled to provide <u>certified peer specialist services</u>, <u>certified family peer specialist services</u> and <u>certified peer recovery services</u> according to state standards
