## Minnesota Substance Use Disorder Community of Practice Meeting Overview

The Minnesota Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Community of Practice (CoP) consists of people who are engaged in the field of SUD treatment and prevention in any capacity including, but not limited to, people with lived experience, providers, family members, researchers, recovery peers, state agency and county health and human service representatives, health plan representatives and advocates. The group will issue reports and recommendations to the stakeholders throughout Minnesota.

During the CoP, participants will discuss methods for Developing an SUD Quality Framework for Minnesota. Objectives for the meeting include:

- Provide CoP members with a brief overview of quality concepts and components of a comprehensive quality strategy;
- Discuss unique challenges of monitoring quality for SUD and mental health services and systems;
- Provide CoP members with a brief overview of intersection of quality monitoring and ability for systems to meaningfully participate in alternative payment or value-based models; and
